**RE: 16-inch D.I.P. Water Supply Redundancy Project for the University Area
Hospital Complex, Project No. 513504947**

The Salt Lake City Department of Public Utilities will install 2,305 linear feet of 16-inch Ductile Iron Water Pipe from the Huntsman Cancer Institute at the University of Utah, 2000 Circle of Hope (Medical Drive) to East of Fort Douglas Circle (1925 East) to Federal Pointe Drive (360 North and 1700 East) during the next few months.

Most of the work will be off road but traffic on Medical Drive may be affected by occasional construction trucks coming and going from the construction area. Access to the construction area will be through the Jewish Community Center (JCC). Hiking and biking in this area may also be affected. Specific dates and detours will be posted.

The contractor for the work is Noland & Son Construction Company, Inc., (801) 566-7219. Tony Treasure is the project manager and Von Lovendahl is the project superintendent.
