1. **Petition CED2009-00002: 678 North H Street** – A request by Dominique Babcock, neighbor, appealing the Planning Commission (PLNSUB2008-00680) decision to approve the request by Celtic Bank for planned development approval of two principal structures on a single lot, and primary entrance on the side facade, located at approximately 678 North H Street. The project consists of removing the central section of a large single family home to create a duplex and single family home. The project is located in an SR-1A (Special Development Pattern Residential) zoning district located in City Council District Three, represented by Eric Jergensen.
