**Item 3**      Crime Report

Each month the Salt Lake City Police Department prepares a report of criminal activity for each Community Council area. Statistics show that crime is lowered in part, due to good citizens keeping a watchful eye on our homes and streets and reporting concerns to our SLC Police officers. The website that records all criminal activity for the city is again operational. You can access this information by going to [www.slcpd.com](http://www.slcpd.com).

The total offenses for our community jumped dramatically from 38 to 78. Specifically: auto thefts went from 10 to 11, gang related from 3 to 3, burglary incidents stayed at 3, car prowls from 5 to 21 and damaged property reports went from 10 to 27, this number includes damage to businesses, homes, cars and graffiti damage.
