Item 3 Crime Report

Each month the Salt Lake City Police Department prepares a report of criminal activity for each Community Council area. Statistics show that crime is lowered in part, due to good citizens keeping a watchful eye on our homes and streets and reporting concerns to our SLC Police officers in a timely way. The website that records all criminal activity for the city can be accessed by going to www.slcpd.com.

The total offenses in our community for the month of March 2009 increased from 32 to 50. Specifically: auto thefts went from 7 to 13, gang related from 5 to 3, burglary incidents from 1 to 8, car prowls from 3 to 6, and damaged property reports went from 11 to 12, this number includes damage to businesses, homes, cars and graffiti damage. We have shared only 5 of the 11 areas that are reported monthly.

Information is available on how you can be more involved in our community crime prevention through our Neighborhood Watch and Mobil Watch programs. These programs are working for us. Drug busts were held on 9th N and 9th W and in the Rain-Tree Apartments. Get involved! Stay involved! Contact a member of the Rose Park CC Board for information.
