Item 3 Crime Report

Each month the Salt Lake City Police Department prepares a report of criminal activity for each Community Council area. Statistics show that crime is lowered in part, due to good citizens keeping a watchful eye on our homes and streets and reporting concerns to our SLC Police officers in a timely way. The website that records all criminal activity for the city can be accessed by going to www.slcpd.com.

The total offenses in our community for the month of April 2009 decreased from 56 to 41. Specifically: auto thefts went from 15 to 5, gang related from 3 to 5, burglary incidents from 9 to 5, car prowls from 7 to 4, and damaged property reports went from 16 to 13, this number includes damage to businesses, homes, cars and graffiti damage. We have shared only 5 of the 11 areas that are reported monthly.

Information is available on how you can be more involved in our community crime prevention through our Neighborhood Watch and Mobil Watch programs. These programs are working for us. Drug busts were conducted on 8th N & 12th W, 11th N & 14th W, 5th N & 10th W, 9th N & 9th W, and 6th N & 12th W. This work resulted in 10 felony arrests. We CAN push these people out of our area.
