1-Brad welcomed everyone

Second, T Mobile is requesting to remove and antennae and replace it with a taller one. T Mobile has a lease agreement already with the property owner. Third, Qwest has requested to install 5 new utility boxes throughout the neighborhoods. A public Hearing will be held on December 18th @ 5:30 PM in the City and County Building.
