

## *Salt Lake City Council Fast Facts*

**What:** A public hearing regarding a proposed appropriation resolution for Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Rehousing program funds and approving an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Salt Lake City and the US Department of Housing and Urban Development.

**When:** Tuesday, August 11, 2009 at 7:00 p.m.

**Where:** City & County Building, 451 S State St., Room 315

### **Points of Interest:**

- In July 2009, Salt Lake City will receive one-time Homelessness Prevention and Rapid ReHousing grant funds in the amount of \$1,680,347 from HUD under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. Funds for this program are intended to target individuals and families who are: a) currently in housing but are at risk of becoming homeless and need temporary rent, utility or relocation assistance; and b) who are experiencing homelessness and need temporary assistance to acquire and retain permanent housing.
- Adoption of this resolution allows the City to: a) allocate funds outside the limits of Salt Lake City but within the limits of Salt Lake County to ensure that clients are placed in the best housing situation possible; and b) meet the federal requirements to finalize the appropriate written agreements and obligate the funds to appropriate recipients
