When: Tuesday, July 14, 2009 – City Council Public Hearing

Points of Interest:

On May 6, the Council received a follow-up briefing where it was decided that the proposed ordinance would be revised and distributed for public review and comment in the near future.

The purpose of the board would be to:

- Provide and oversee stewardship of the City's parks, trails and urban forest.
- Educate the public and advocate for the City's parks, trails and urban forest policies.
- Encourage and facilitate public involvement,
- Incorporate public input into the City's parks, trails and urban forest plans and policies.
