City Council Briefing on Main Street Plaza Proposal To Be Televised on Salt Lake City Cable Channel

The Salt Lake City Council will receive a briefing on a proposed ordinance that would relinquish a pedestrian access easement on the Main Street Plaza in exchange for donations to build a new community center on Tuesday, May 27. The briefing will start at 5:30 p.m. in Room 326 of the City & County Building, 451 South State Street.

The briefing will be televised on Salt Lake City's cable television channel, Channel 17.

The briefing will take place during a City Council work session, so no public comment will be taken during the briefing. The City Council has scheduled a public hearing on the proposed ordinance at its regularly scheduled formal hearing on Tuesday, June 3 at 6 p.m.

The proposed ordinance would relinquish a pedestrian access easement on the Main Street Plaza between North Temple and South Temple streets. In exchange, the City would receive two acres of land and cash donations to build a new community center at 1385 South 900 West.

The City Council will not take formal action on the proposed ordinance at the Tuesday work session.
