Salt Lake City Council Work Session **Neighborhood Outreach Meeting in Council District Four**

[Salt Lake City, Utah] - This year, the Salt Lake City Council has been holding a regularly scheduled Work Session meeting in each City Council District to give the City Council a chance to hear from those individuals living in these neighborhoods.

The City Council has already met in Council Districts One, Two, Three, Five, Six and Seven. The next scheduled meeting will be held at the Patrick Moore Gallery located at 511 West 200 South in City Council District Four on Thursday, November 9, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. The first 30 minutes of the meeting will be reserved for public comment to provide an opportunity for residents to address the City Council. Comments will be taken on any City-related issues and are limited to two minutes.

Items appearing on the City Council agenda that evening include a presentation regarding communications and decision-making between responding agencies during disaster situations from Dr. Ted Liou of the University of Utah who assisted with the aftermath of the Katrina disaster. The agenda also includes a presentation from various agencies regarding the refugee populations in Salt Lake City.
