Council to Take Comment on Proposed Skywalk at Two Meetings

Property Reserve Inc, the company seeking proposed amendments to Salt Lake City's *Downtown Master Plan* and *Urban Design Element* that – if adopted – would grant exceptions to allow the construction of skywalks above streets under certain circumstances, has requested that a March 20 public hearing on the issue be continued until the City Council meeting April 3.

To honor the request, the Salt Lake City Council plans to take the bulk of public comment at its April 3 meeting. However, it will accept comment at the March 20 hearing from those who had planned to attend the hearing that night instead of asking them to return on April 3. People interested in commenting on the issue are encouraged to attend the April 3 meeting. Those who had planned to attend the March 20 meeting and cannot attend the April 3 meeting still may comment at the March 20 hearing. The hearing is scheduled to start at about 7 p.m. in the City Council Chamber, Room 315, in the City & County Building, 451 South State Street.
