Salt Lake City Council Work Session **Neighborhood Outreach Meeting in District Seven**

[Salt Lake City, Utah] - This year, the Salt Lake City Council will be holding a regularly scheduled Work Session meeting in each City Council District to provide Council Members an opportunity to hear from individuals living in these neighborhoods.

The next scheduled meeting will be held at the Nibley Park Elementary School Auditorium located at 2785 South 800 East in City Council District Seven on Tuesday, March 27, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. The first 30 minutes of the meeting will be reserved for public comment to provide an opportunity for District 7 residents, property owners, and business owners to address the City Council. Comments will be taken on any City-related issue and are limited to two minutes on a first-come, first-served basis.

Items appearing on the City Council agenda that evening include a presentation regarding the Sugar House transit study, an update on historic surveys from the City's Planning Division, and a presentation regarding environmental impacts on air quality by Dr. Arden Pope, Professor of Economics at Brigham Young University.
