The Salt Lake City Council will hold the second of two dialogues Thursday, November 13, on the future of Salt Lake City's economy. The dialogue will start at 3 p.m. in Room 326 of the City & County Building, 451 South State Street.

The dialogue will consist of six presentations of roughly a half-hour each. The dialogue will be televised on Salt Lake City's cable television channel, Channel 17.

Presenters include:

- **Chris Nelson, University of Utah Presidential Professor of City & Metropolitan Planning**, who will present his study of population growth along the Wasatch Front to the year 2040.
- **Doug Hattery and Val Halford of the Wasatch Front Regional Council**, who will discuss the Regional Council's plans to accommodate growth along the Wasatch Front, including its State Street Livability Study.
- **LDS Church Presiding Bishop H. David Burton**, who will give an update of the City Creek Center project and its relationship to future growth.
- **Jake Boyer, president of The Boyer Co.**, who will discuss long-term growth in Salt Lake City and the Gateway Mall's relationship to that growth.
- **Tom Bard, principal of ScanlanKemperBard Companies of Portland**, which owns Trolley Square, who will discuss long-term growth in Salt Lake City and Trolley Square's relationship to that growth.
- **DJ Baxter, Salt Lake City Redevelopment Agency Director**, who will moderate a discussion among a panel that will focus on future housing needs in Salt Lake City. The panel includes Nathan Anderson of First Utah Bank, Dan Lofgren of Cowboy Partners, and Alan Wood of Wood Development.

The City Council held the first dialogue on October 21. The dialogue featured economists and representatives of the City's business community who focused on the near-term future of Salt Lake City's economy. The second dialogue is intended to focus on population and economic growth to the year 2040.
