Fairmont Skate Park “Lights On “Celebration

[Salt Lake City, Utah] — Salt Lake City Council Member Søren Simonsen is inviting the public to the Wednesday, November 26, 2008 celebration of the lighting of the Fairmont Skate Park, 2361 South 900 East, at 5:30 p.m.

“With all the holiday lighting events going on this Thanksgiving week, here is one that will make you smile, at least if you’re a skateboarder, and that will last well beyond the holidays,” says Council Member Simonsen. “This is an exciting event that is two years in the making.”

Simonsen acknowledges the concerted efforts of community members whose hard work and broad support were influential in bringing about this addition to Fairmont Park. Park users put together this proposal to the City and through their efforts the lighting project was finally realized. Simonsen applauds their initiative and hard work.

The lights at the skate park will operate until Fairmont’s designated closing time of 11 p.m. Patrons of the park will have the ability to turn on the lights at the push of a button. This will power up the lights, and start the timer which will last one hour. The lights can then be reset every hour after that until closing time. When 10 minutes remain on the time, the lighting system will alert patrons who can then reset the timer by pushing the button again. The lights will turn off automatically at park closing with a 10-minute warning.
