Non-citizens also qualify if they were lawfully living in the U. S. on August 22, 1996, and were over 65 on that date, are now under 18, or are currently receiving disability payments.

Description of Services: The Neighborhood Center program was created to bring CAP's services closer to the residents of the areas being served. There are five centers in Salt Lake County and one in Tooele County (see below). Emergency food pantries are located in each of these centers. If in need, each member of a family is provided with a three-day supply of food. Clients can receive six food orders in a twelve-month period, although in emergency situations this general rule can be extended. The goal of the program is to help feed families who are desperate for assistance, especially during the winter months. Clients are served on a first-come, first-served basis, and no appointment is required. Their needs are determined by filling out an intake form, which clearly establishes what they need to help them become self-sufficient.
