Parents, Spectators, Volunteers: Spectators and parents will NOT be allowed on the golf course except when assisting as and identified as Official Tournament Volunteers.

Pull Carts, Golf Cars and Caddies: Players may use pull carts. Golf cars and/or caddies will NOT be allowed. Players must walk at all times during a stipulated round except if transportation is provided for all players at specific locations on the golf course. This transportation will be provided by Official Tournament Volunteers.

Tees: Girls 8-10 will play gold tees	Boys 8-10 will play red tees
Girls 11-12 will play gold tees	Boys 11-12 will play white tees
Girls 13-14 will play red tees	Boys 13-14 will play white tees
Girls 15-17 will play red tees	Boys 15-17 will play blue tees

Prizes: Trophies will be awarded to the top three two-day scores in each division. A sudden death playoff will decide ties for 1st place. Pro shop merchandise certificates will be awarded in each division based on the number of entries in that division.
