Located in downtown Salt Lake City, Pioneer Park was re-opened on June 14, 2008, with increased infrastructure to encourage use of the park as a Neighborhood Park. A Partners Team drawn from the immediate neighbors of the park - residents, businesses, homeless community representatives, other property owners, and local police – has been working to implement strategies to ensure the park's safety and livability. The group's first focus was an extensive effort to encourage regular ongoing activities during all hours that the park was open during summer 2008 (extended to 11 pm). The group obtained a variety of community commitments for recurring and one-time events, including daily lunch-time activities, morning yoga, a Friday night international movie series, a Sunday international market, and Sunday evening BBQ and bocce.

The opportunities to enjoy Pioneer Park are expanding in 2009.

The Salt Lake City Council and Salt Lake Solutions co-hosted a public workshop in December to revisit the phases 2 and 3 design plans for Pioneer Park. The invited participants

were asked to confirm whether the existing plans still meet the needs of the changing neighborhood, and to prioritize individual design components.

The final report from the public workshop reflects the following major themes about the current needs at Pioneer Park:

- To increase the actual and perceived safety and security of the park, any additional construction in the park should support increased programming and create spaces that encourage the larger Salt Lake community to visit the park.
- The bathrooms should be replaced.
