STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING

In accordance with Title 12, Chapter 12.64, City Permit Parking Program, of the Salt Lake City Code, 1987 and the Federal Area (Area 2) Declaration of Designation, the undersigned understands and agrees to the following provisions related to the Program including issuance of a City Parking Permit.

- A. Applicant is a bonafide resident of the designated City Permit Parking Area. (Resident shall mean a person who is a member in good standing and resides on a regular basis on the premises of a Greek Social Organization located within the permit boundary.)**
- B. The motor vehicle described herein is owned or controlled by resident applicant. (Controlled shall mean applicant has authorization from registered owner to operate the vehicle on a full-time basis.) Motor vehicle shall not exceed 10,000 pounds gross weight.**
- C. City Permit Parking decals shall be affixed and displayed on authorized vehicle in accordance with the permit display instructions. Permits are non-transferable from one vehicle to another.**
- D. It is unlawful and a violation of the program for resident applicant to falsely represent himself/herself as eligible for a parking permit or to furnish false information on this application.**
- E. It is unlawful and a violation of the program for resident applicant holding a valid permit to allow the use or display of such permit on a motor vehicle other than that for which the permit is issued.**
- F. It is unlawful and a violation of the program for resident applicant to copy, produce a facsimile of or otherwise counterfeit or attempt to use a falsified City Parking Permit.**
- G. Faithful compliance with the terms of the City Parking Permit Program by resident applicant is a condition subsequent to the privilege of obtaining and retaining a permit. Violation of the terms of the CPP Area 2 shall be deemed a forfeiture of those privileges. The Transportation Engineer is granted authority by Code to revoke the City Parking permit (s) of any person/organization found to be in violation of the program; subsequent penalty/fine may result.**
