

Minutes for MBAC
December 13th 2006

1. Mike Sanderson briefly discussed his medical school project to the MBAC. He is looking at the effectiveness of our organization. A full report will take place in January.
2. Transportation: Dan Bergenthal reported that Phase 1 of the Beck street project will start in the spring. He reminded everyone to call him with maintenance needs in bike lanes. He will look at an uneven surface exiting the mouth of Emigration Canyon where the recent reconstruction took place.
3. The bulk of the meeting was spent discussing a proposed helmet ordinance by the city for all ages. The issues were narrowed down. It was decided that the MBAC does not support an "all ages" helmet law at this time. However the group in attendance was split on the issue of a helmet law for those less than 18. Attached is a letter that I sent to Mayor Anderson on behalf of the MBAC. Further discussion of an ordinance for those under 18 will be discussed and presented at the next MBAC meeting.
4. New Business: the upper portion of City Creek Canyon will be repaired this year though it is unclear if the repair will be a surface repair or a complete repaving. There is going to be a connecting route of 22nd west to North Salt Lake occurring this spring.
